the principles 1 of economics and practice - pearson - economics, the second of the two types of economic analysis, advises individuals and society on their choices. normative economics is about what people ought to do. normative economics is almost always dependent on subjective judgments, which means that normative analysis depends at least in part on personal feelings, tastes, or opinions.

economic principles of constitutions: an economic analysis ... - this tradition mainly falls into the second type of law and economics analysis, the functional interpretation of institutions based on the premise that, with time and barring obstacles, the law will develop towards efficient arrangements.
